## Schooling during the coronavirus pandemic

## **SCENARIO**

## WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?



- → Lessons at school for everyone in specific, unchanging learning groups.
- → There may be restrictions relating to individual subjects, year groups or all-day learning.
- → Hygiene rules must be observed (e.g. coverings for mouth and nose, regular hand-washing, ventilation).
- → People who belong to at-risk groups can learn and work from home.

B

- → Alternating model learning groups are divided, with one half learning at school and the other half at home on an alternating basis.
- → Hygiene rules must be observed; distancing requirements also apply.
- → All-day schooling will not be available.
- → 'Emergency groups' (e.g. for children of key workers) are available for Years 1 to 6.
- → People who belong to at-risk groups can learn and work from home.



- → Distance learning no in-school teaching; pupils work from home.
- → 'Emergency groups' (e.g. for children of key workers) are available for Years 1 to 6.
- → Schoolwork is mandatory and performance will be evaluated.
- → Teaching staff are available (by telephone, e-mail or in person at the school) at designated times and will assist with schoolwork.
- → Pupils must also be available for contact by the school.
